



## SOAR INTO STEM: MENTORS IN AVIATION

As a SOAR into STEM Mentor, you will work with high school students using lessons designed by educators to inspire and educate students about the many exciting possibilities available to them through STEM and aviation careers. ### How it works:

- A background in aviation-related careers is required.
- Mentors will be matched with a group of 3-4 high school students with whom they will work each Saturday afternoon. This includes sharing your background, answering questions about your field, and engaging students in meaningful conversation about the world of STEM and aviation.
- Mentor time is 2-3 p.m., Saturdays — March 30, April 6, 13 and 20, 2024 — at the Wings of Hope hangar. Mentors are also welcome to participate in the full day from 8:30 a.m.– 3 p.m. as well as the discovery flights and Career Fair on April 27.
- Training and materials will be provided.
