Meet Caleb

Caleb was born with his right femur shorter than his left. Wings of Hope flies him from his home in Wichita, Kans., to Shriners Children's St. Louis to lengthen his leg — a process that requires multiple surgeries and years of treatment. The 16-year-old had his first appointment in St. Louis when he was only two and has flown with Wings of Hope about 20 roundtrip flights.

Caleb plans to return to Shriners for one final leg-lengthening surgery in the summer of 2026. He and his mom will stay in St. Louis about 4-6 weeks for post-surgery appointments. Then, Wings of Hope will fly him back to Shriners every other week, at first, and periodically for the next 18-24 months — until his leg is fully healed.
