



SOAR into STEM: Mentors in Aviation

Volunteer to change a young life today! As a SOAR into STEM Mentor, you will work with high school students using lessons designed by educators to inspire students about the many exciting possibilities available to them through STEM and aviation careers. How it works:

- A background in aviation-related careers is required.
- SOAR into STEM is held twice a year. Spring program runs from end of March through April, and Fall program runs October through mid-November.
- Mentors are asked to attend 4 Saturday's from 11:30 am – 3 pm at the Wings of Hope hangar. Mentors are encouraged to participate in the full day from 8:30 am – 3:00 pm plus week 5 for student Discovery Flights and Career Fair.
- Mentors will be matched with a group of 2 – 4 high school students with whom they will work each Saturday afternoon. This includes sharing your background, answering questions about your field, and engaging students in meaningful conversation about the world of STEM and aviation.
- Training and materials will be provided.

What you need to do:

- Agree to a background check.
- Complete a program orientation.
