# MAT Program IMPACT

Since 2003, the Medical Relief & Air Transport (MAT) Program has provided a vital lifeline to individuals facing serious medical conditions by flying them to specialized care that is otherwise inaccessible. Offered completely free-of-charge, the MAT program ensures that patients and their families can focus on healing rather than logistics or financial hardship.

We fly patients to hospitals and medical centers in 26 states within an 800-mile radius of our St. Louis area headquarters.

## SOAR into STEM IMPACT

SOAR into STEM is a hands-on learning experience that brings high school students into our hangar to expand their knowledge of flight, mechanics, communications and navigation, and engineering. Each five week session culminates with a career fair and with students taking Young Eagles Discovery Flights.
